






Day 0I - Hadiboh Arhar Beach

- Check in at 6:30AM and departure Abu Dhabi at 9:25AM
- Arrival to Socotra at 10:40AM
- After lunch we will drive to the North-East of the island to Arher where a fresh creak coming out from granite massive is meeting salty sea water on the beach
- You can relax on green grass around the creak, swim in the sea or if you feel fit you can climb a huge sand dune to get a fantastic view over this charming dinner
- Overnight in Arhar














Day 02 - Arhar - Hoq's Cave/Ras Ersil

- A steep hike to Hoq's cave (4 hours). This is one of the most important spots on the island
- Drive to Ras Erisel, the meeting point of the Arabic Sea and the Indian Ocean
- Walk back to the camp














Day 03 - Homhil and Dihamri Marine Protected Area

- Head to Homhil National Park; Here you can see the famous Dragon blood trees but as well many others, like the bottletree and the cucumber plant
- After an hour walking we'll reach an amazing crystal clear pool with a view over the Southern part of Socotra
- Drive to Dihamri Marine Protected Area
- Diving, snorking or joining local fishermen on the sea
- Overnight at Dihamri












Day 04 - Wadi Kaisahan, Zahak Sand Dunes

- Drive to the Mumi Plateau; This famous place that you enjoy the stunning landscape of huge swimming pool
- Lunch will be on the top of wadi Kslisahan or Qaria lagoon
- We'll drive to the south of the island visit sand dunes and Degoub cave
- Overnight near to the sand dunes














Day 05 - Dixam Plateau Dirhour Canyon Fermahin Forest

- After visiting the Degoub Cave in the morning, we'll drive to the Diksam plateau
- We'll stop in Wadi Dirhur to enjoy a refreshing swim and have lunch
- Later, we'll visit the Firmihin forest, which has the highest concentration of Dragon's Blood Trees in Socotra.
- Dinner and overnight stay at a camp atop the Diksam Plateau to enjoy the sunset over the Dragon's Blood Trees











Day 06 - Qalansiya Detwah

 We start the day by driving to Qalansyia, a charming and picturesque fishing town known for its traditional houses and narrow alleyways

 In the afternoon, we visit the protected Detwah Lagoon, renowned for its spectacular landscape. Stingrays can often be seen in the lagoon, so take care while swimming

 We will enjoy the sunset from the top of the local mountain, followed by an overnight stay at Detwah Lagoon











Day 07 - Detwah Lagoon

- Embark on a boat tour to the stunning Shoab Beach;
 Along the way, keep an eye out for spinner dolphins and
 frequenting Cormorants. Once at Shoab, you'll have
 the opportunity to swim, enjoy line fishing from the
 boat, and relax on this pristine beach surrounded by
 mangroves.
- Overnight at Detwah Lagoon, complete with festivities for your final evening!









Day 08 - Detwah Lagoon, Airport, Abu Dhabi

- Closing Circle
- After enjoying one last succulent breakfast, we'll head back to the airport. It will be time to say goodbye, with our eyes and heart filled with warm memories.

Is Socotra safe?

Unlike mainland Yemen, Socotra has been enjoying stability and security, making it an ideal destination for travelers seeking solace and serenity. The local community is welcoming and eager to share their rich culture and heritage with visitors. This is still true in 2025!

How to get there?

Book a flight from Cairo to Abu Dhabi , with our assistance of course. Then we book for you Abu Dhabi - Socotra flight. Today you can reach Socotra with a weekly NON-STOP DIRECT FLIGHT from Abu Dhabi. It's a governmental charter flight and they do not offer online booking yet. This means that in order to get a seat on this in demand flight you need to be assisted by us. To ease this process we use our local contacts to help make your flight reservations.











How do I get a visa to Socotra?

Visas for Socotra must be arranged through a travel agency. You will need to provide a scanned copy of your passport photo page. We will handle the application process and provide you with a digital visa.

Is this the right trip for me?

This is primarily a trekking/backpacking and overland trip through the mountains and coastlines of Socotra. Infrastructure on the island is very basic, don't expect great internet access or even mobile connection, air conditioning, or squeaky clean toilets. But expect a retreat of your dreams.
